

MILITARY COMBAT SCHOOL – ARMED COMBAT TECHNIQUES AND TACTICS OF POLICE INTERVENTION

This training is recommended to instructors teaching classes in the uniformed services, law-enforcement agencies as well as security officers who work with weapons. The theme of the course is manifold: self-defense, close combat, intervention techniques and tactics as well as combat with the use of individual weapons (among other things, tasks fulfilled by soldiers and members of other uniformed services both during the time of peace and the areas where military activities take place). The program has been created by Polish instructors of the European Federation of Krav-Maga and approved by the Polish Armed Forces.

The training will be coached by:

Captain Włodzimierz KOPEĆ – the main instructor of hand-to-hand combat and armed combat in the Polish Armed Forces. II Dan KM, Vice-chair of the Polish chapter of the European Federation of Krav-Maga.

Reserve major Piotr TARNAWSKI – specialist in military combat, I Dan KM, Chair of the Polish chapter of the European Federation of Krav-Maga.

Captain Jacek KACZMARZYK – military specialist / instructor of armed combat.

- THE FOLLOWING ISSUES WILL BE DEALT WITH:

MILITARY CLOSE COMBAT AND TECHNIQUES AND TACTICS OF POLICE INTERVENTION:

- safe falling with a weapon
- defense against an attempt to grab a weapon
- attack and defense with the use of various weapons
- activities without weapons (punches and kicks)
- defense against choking and holds
- using incapacitating chokes and holds
- transportation techniques
- checking sb's ID
- overcoming stiff resistance during intervention
- usage of technical means of coercion (baton, cuffs, etc.)

COMBAT AND A SAFE USAGE OF SHOOTING WEAPONS (INDIVIDUAL ONES)

- safety rules in conducting classes with the "BLOS" weapon
- dynamic shooting (small arms and machine guns)
- usage of individual arms in close combat
- VIP protection
- methodology of armed combat teaching

- A participant should have/be equipped with:
 - field uniform and boots suitable for field classes; sport uniform plus sneakers/training shoes suitable for gyms
 - groin and teeth protectors
 - individual personal accident insurance
- The cost of participation is:
